


GOLROKH NOURI FACULTY OF SCIENCE

You can start planning your courses. It's exciting.



1. FIND YOUR PROGRAM

When you apply for admission to SFU, you will choose a faculty and a program. Whether or not you already know what you want to study, our website has descriptions and career information for all our programs.

2. CHECK YOUR REQUIREMENTS

Admission requirements vary depending on

- · Which program you want to study
- · Where you're currently studying
- What curriculum you're studying

3. MEET THE END OF **JANUARY DEADLINE**

Most students start at SFU in the fall term (September), but you can also apply to start in the spring (January) or summer term (May).

High school students can submit applications for September 2024 starting on October 1, 2023. The application period closes on January 31, 2024.
