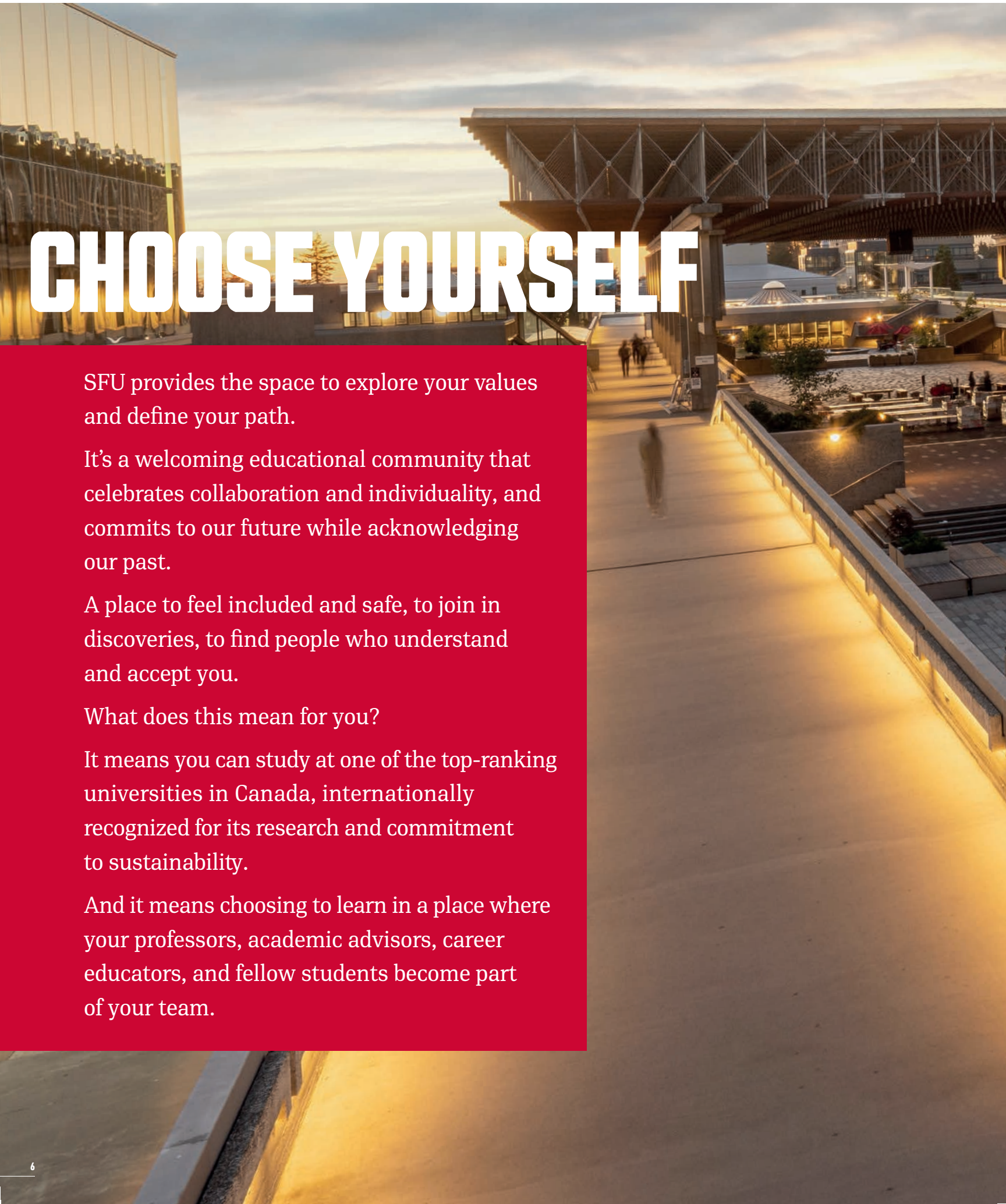
GOLROKH NOURI

Her interest in neuroscience and pharmacology led to work on federally funded research, using her math skills to improve our understanding of drug tolerance. You can start planning your courses. It's exciting.

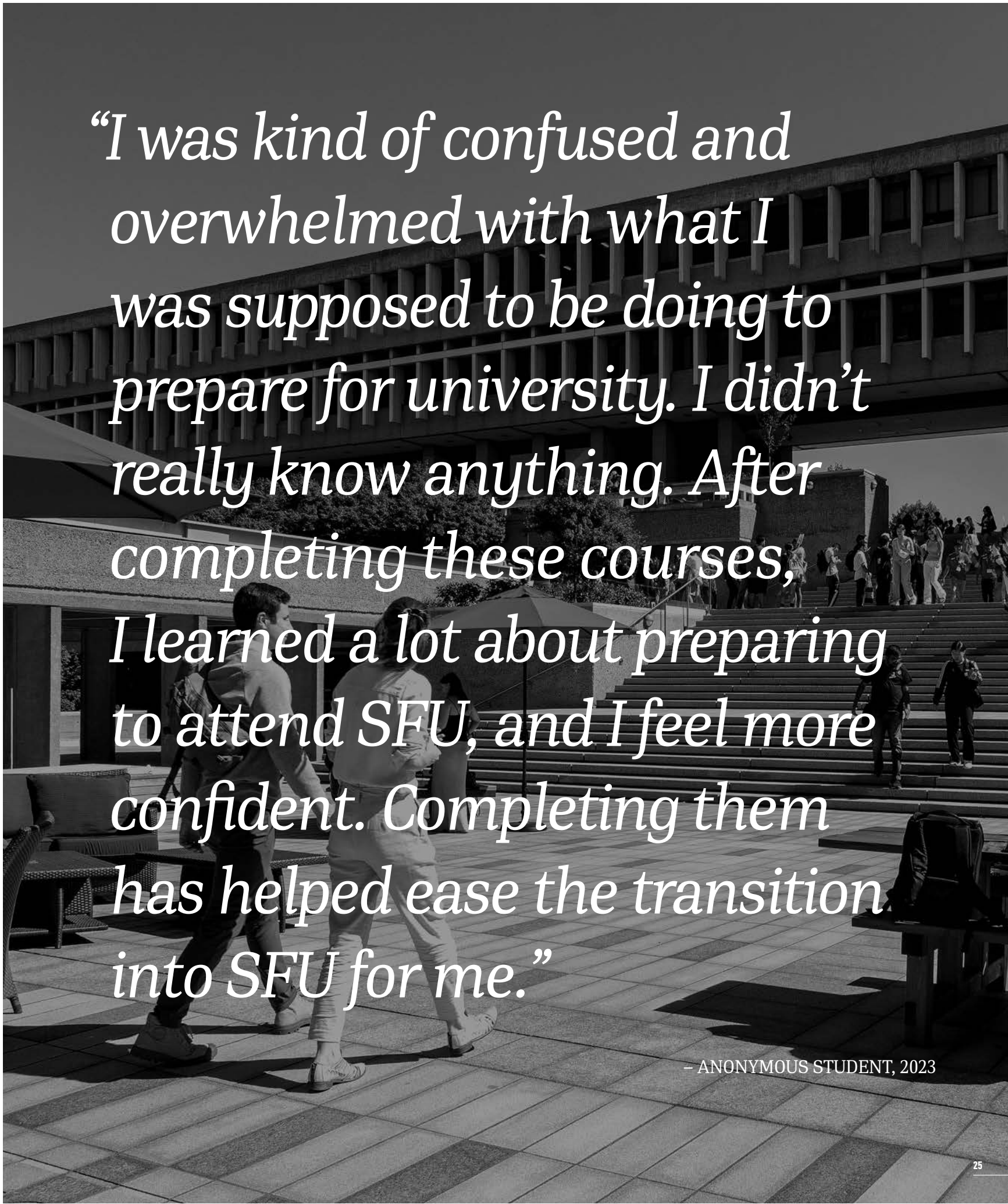
WE'LL GET YOU SET UP FOR YOUR FIRST TERM

APPLY

1. FIND YOUR PROGRAM

When you apply for admission to SFU, you will choose a faculty and a program. Whether or not you already know what you want to study, our website has descriptions and career information for all our programs.

2. CHECK YOUR REQUIREMENTS

Admission requirements vary depending on

- Which program you want to study
- Where you're currently studying
- What curriculum you're studying

Our admission website lists the specific requirements for all programs across a variety of curricula.

You'll also find special admission information for Indigenous, and International Baccalaureate students.

3. MEET THE END OF JANUARY DEADLINE

Most students start at SFU in the fall term (September), but you can also apply to start in the spring (January) or summer term (May).

High school students can submit applications for September 2024 starting on October 1, 2023. The application period closes on January 31, 2024.

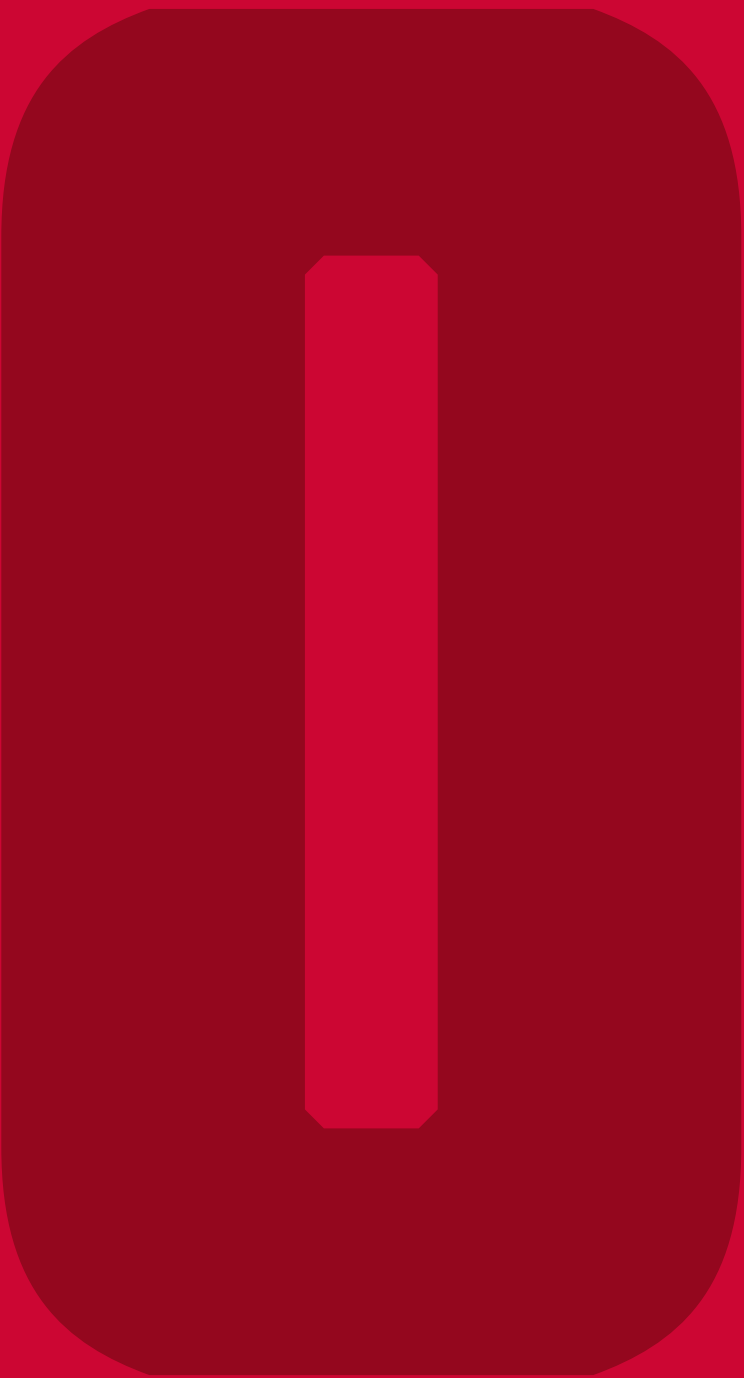
