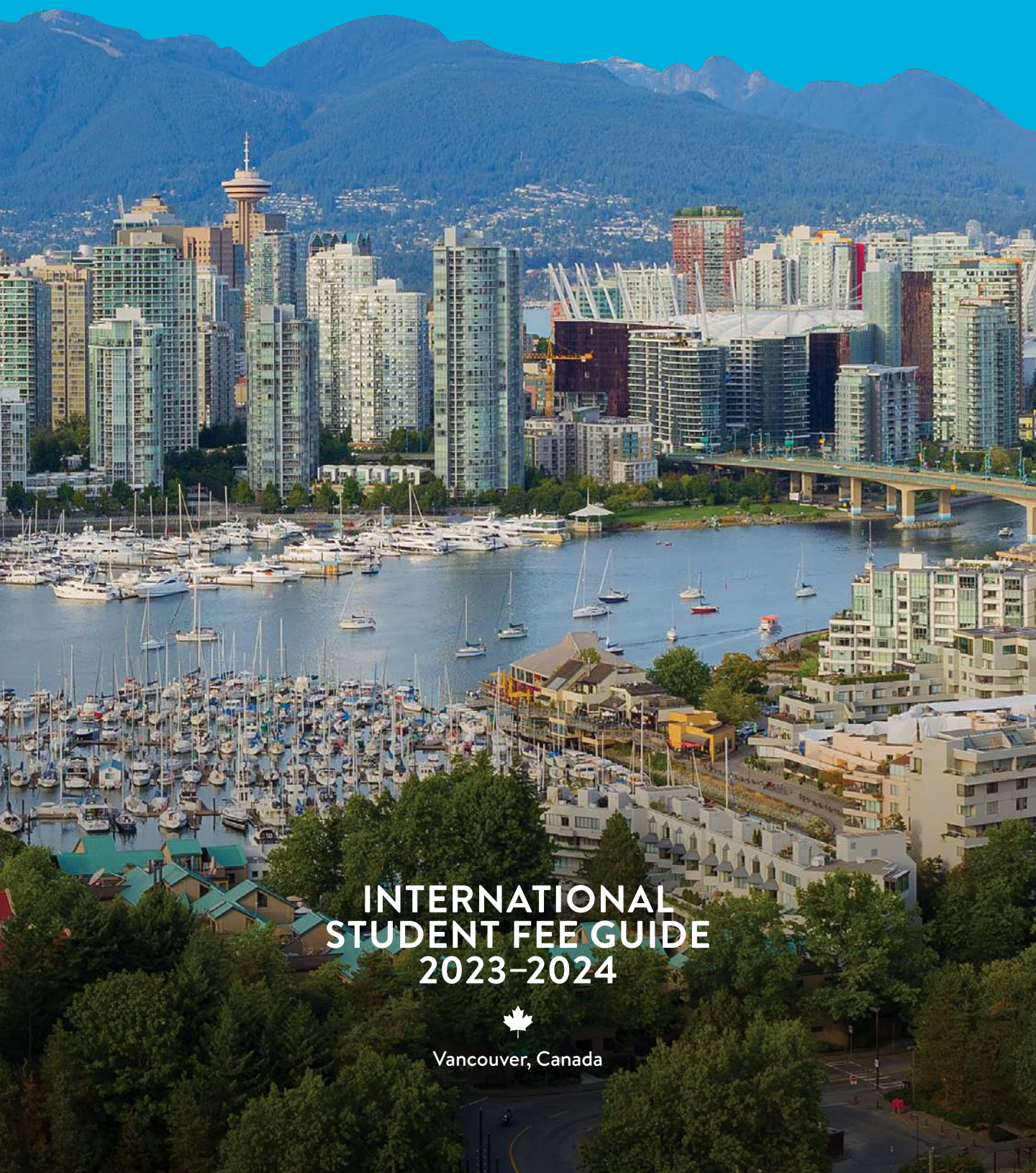

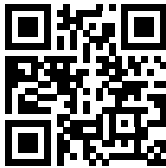

You will be eligible to apply for the Post-Graduation Work Permit (PGWP) program upon successful completion of most CapU programs.

Note: Certificate programs qualify for a one-year PGWP, and Diploma or Bachelor programs qualify for a three-year PGWP.
