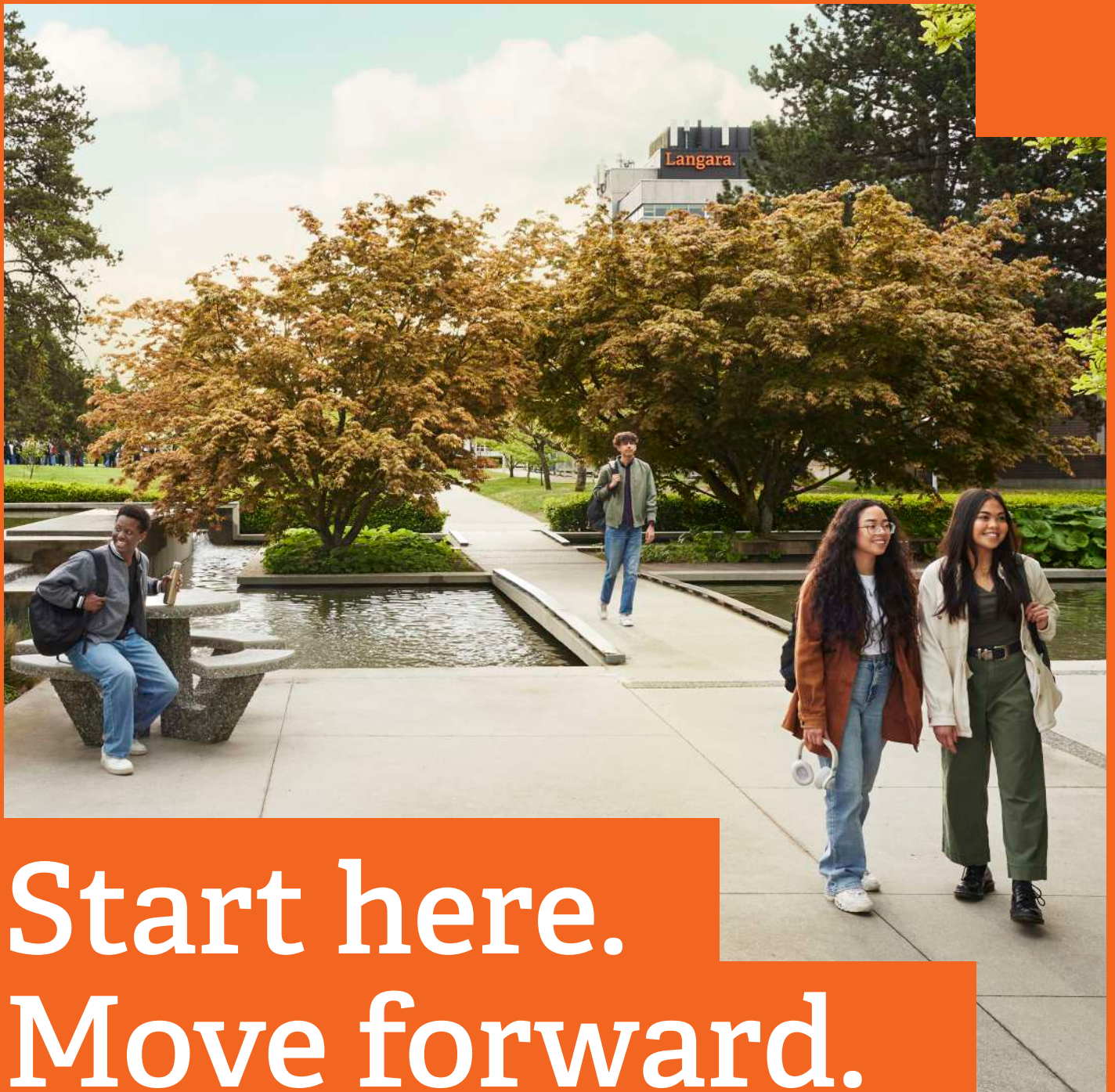

CO-OPERATIVE EDUCATION (CO-OP)

Some programs provide students the option to alternate full-time study with paid work terms to supplement education costs. International co-operative education (co-op) students must apply for a Co-op Work Permit through Immigration Canada. Eligible international students can work part-time without a work permit.

Combine learning with travel by participating in a field school or exchange program. Whether you're studying business in Seoul or exploring history in Rome – an educational adventure awaits.
