 4. Should you receive an email from Seneca College Admissions requesting additional information or documents, please respond in a timely manner
 5. Seneca will email your admission decision to the email address you provided on your application
 6. When you receive your offer of admission, pay your first semester fees by the deadline stated in your offer and fees notice
 7. Apply for a Canadian Study Permit
