ANSWER: Four examples of human-made environment—buildings, parks, bridges and roads.



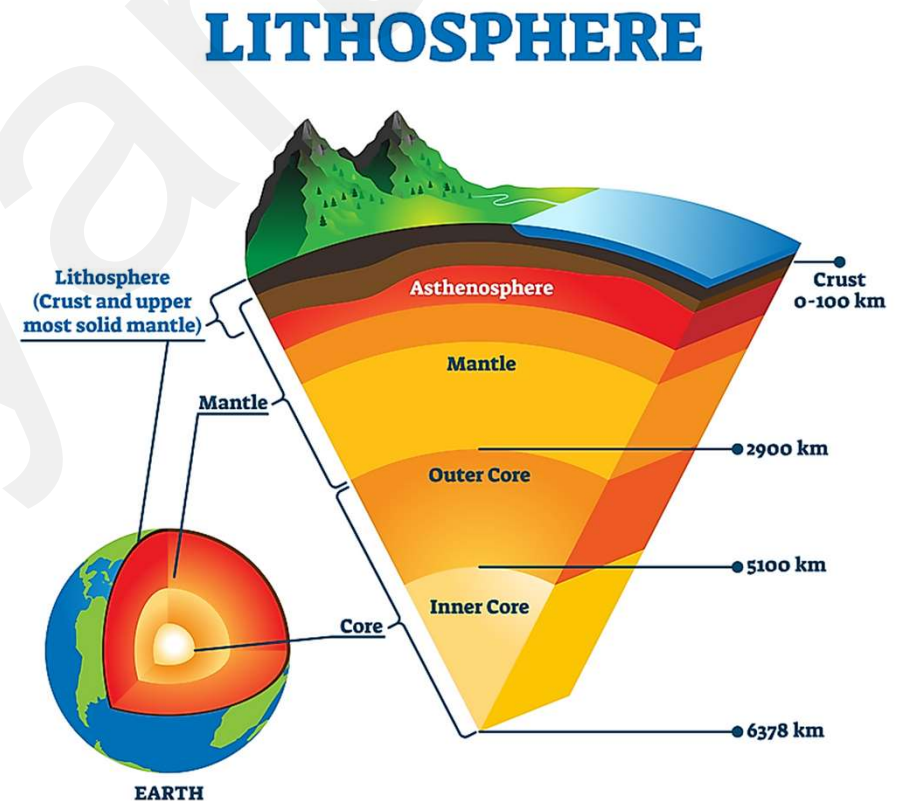
