- Municipal corporations is a local governing body.
- It offer a wide range of services which are primarily funded by the government itself.

- Municipal corporations are divided into various departments.
- These departments are responsible for the working of the different regions of the city.
- Municipal corporations collect the money from the citizens of the city through various taxes and funds for its working.

☐ Functions of Municipal corporations

- •They work towards cleaning the streets and even lighting them regularly.
- •They are essentially responsible for supplying safe drinking water to the citizens.

- •They also regulate the traffic and look into managing the crowd on roads.
- •They offer sanitization services for schools and hospitals.
- •They collect garbage and even its disposal

Some major sources of funds are:

- 1.<u>Taxes</u>: Taxes on properties, vehicles, entertainment, services and advertisement;
- 2.Rents and fees/charges: Charges for water supply, sewer system; Licenses fees, Rents of the community Halls, Barat Ghars and Shops etc.;
- 3. Grants from the State government;
- **4.Fines:** Fines from the tax offenders, lawbreakers, encroachments etc.
