place, people, things and nature that surround any living organism is called environment, it is a combination of both human made and natural phenomena i.e. biotic and abiotic conditions.




### **ATMOSPHERE**

> A THIN LAYER OF AIR THAT SURROUNDS THE EARTH.






- It protects from UV rays and scorching heat of sun.

- Narrow zone of the earth where land water and air interact i.e. atmosphere, lithosphere, hydrosphere.






