.मदर टेरेसा हमारे युग की एक महान संत आत्मा थीं। स्कोपेजी, मेसीडोनिया में 26 अगस्त, 1910 को उनका जन्म हुआ था। वह एक अलबेनियन भवन-निर्माता (बिल्डर) की सबसे छोटी संतान थीं। उनके बचपन का नाम एगनेस था पर मदर टेरेसा के नाम से प्रसिद्ध हुई। बचपन में ही मदर टेरेसा ने एक नन बनने की कसम खाई थी। 1931 से 1948 तक वह कोलकाता के सेन्ट मेरी हाई स्कूल में

नाबेल पुरस्कार प्राप्त करते समय जब उनसे पूछा गया कि दुनिया में शांति को कैसे बहाल किया जा सकता है, तो उनका जवाब था कि लोगों को अपने-अपने घरों में जाकर अपने परिवार के साथ प्रेमपूर्वक रहना चाहिए।

5 सितम्बर, 1997 के दिन मदर टेरेसा हमें छोड़ गईं। अपनी मृत्यु के वक्त, उनके दान हेतु संचालित मिशनरिज में चार हजार से ज्यादा सिस्टर्स थीं

और तीन सौ से ज्यादा लोग उनसे जुड़कर 123 देशों में दस से ज्यादा क्षेत्रों में सेवा कार्यों का संचालन कर रहे थे। इन कार्यों में शामिल था एच.आई. वी./एड्स, कुष्ठ रोग और टीबी से ग्रस्त रोगियों के लिए अस्पतालों और आश्रय-स्थलों (आश्रमों/निवास) की स्थापना, बच्चों और परिवार के लिए परामर्श देना, व्यक्तिगत तौर पर मजदूरों की सहायता उपलब्ध करवाना और अनाथालयों व स्कूलों का संचालन करना।

भारत सरकार ने मदर टेरेसा को उनकी मृत्योपरांत राजकीय सम्मान के साथ आखिरी विदाई दी। उन्होंने भारत के सभी धर्मों के गरीबों और लाचारों के प्रति समान करुणा ही नहीं दिखाई बल्कि उनकी हर प्रकार से सेवा की, सहारा दिया। उनके इस महान् व्यक्तित्व को नमन करने हेतु भारत सरकार ने कृतज्ञतापूर्ण हो उनकी आखिर यात्रा ससम्मान सम्पन्न की।
